UPDATE

! ALL FRESHWATER ANGLERS MUST BE IN POSSESSION OF THE RELEVANT ENVIRONMENT AGENCY FISHING LICENCE

- ✓ YOU SHOULD ONLY TRAVEL TO FISHING VENUES ON YOUR OWN OR WITH MEMBERS OF YOUR HOUSEHOLD & ABIDE BY GUIDELINES ON SOCIAL DISTANCING
- ✓ YOU CAN FISH WITH MEMBERS OF YOUR HOUSEHOLD OR ONE PERSON OUTSIDE YOUR HOUSEHOLD - BUT STICK TO SOCIAL DISTANCING GUIDELINES
- ✓ MAINTAIN A DISTANCE OF 15M FROM OTHER ANGLERS WHILST FISHING
- ✓ ONLY TRAVEL BASED ON WHAT IS ALLOWED BY CURRENT GOVERNMENT GUIDELINES
- ✓ MAKE SURE YOU HAVE PERMISSION TO FISH BEFORE TRAVELLING. MANY CLUBS & FISHERIES HAVE IMPLEMENTED BOOKING SYSTEMS. FISHING WITHOUT PERMISSION IS ILLEGAL
- ✓ KAYAK AND BOAT FISHING IS PERMITTED IN FRESHWATER
- ✓ PAY CAREFUL ATTENTION TO CLUB & FISHERY NOTICES - IF UNSURE SPEAK TO A VENUE FOR GUIDANCE
- ✓ USE HAND SANITISER BEFORE & AFTER TOUCHING LOCKS, GATES ETC HANDLED BY OTHER ANGLERS. DISPOSABLE GLOVES ARE RECOMMENDED
- ✓ MATCH FISHING IS PERMITTED IN LINE WITH BEST PRACTICE GUIDANCE
- ✓ KEEPNETS MAY BE USED BY ALL ANGLERS
- ✗ DO NOT LEAVE HOME IF YOU HAVE SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19 & FOLLOW GOVERNMENT ADVICE ON ISOLATION
- ✗ NO SHARING OF FISHING POSITIONS / PEGS EXCEPT BY MEMBERS OF THE SAME HOUSEHOLD
- ✗ NO SHARING OF FISHING TACKLE OR OTHER ITEMS
